

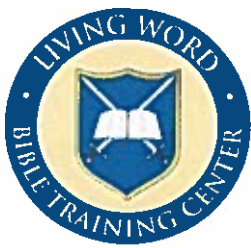

Classes	Descriptions
<p>How to Study the Bible Monday – 9/18 – 11/06/23 7:00 pm – 9:00 pm Minister John King</p>	<p>This course is designed to teach basic fundamentals of studying God's word. It is designed to help the believer rightly divide the Word of Truth and develop methods to search the scriptures you need for instructions for others and insight for your life.</p>
<p>New Testament Survey Tuesday 9/19 – 11/07/23 7:00 pm – 9:00 pm Minister Amir V. Rauf</p>	<p>New Testament Survey is an <i>accelerated</i> course, which highlights the important themes, perspectives and foundational truths as well as the overall significance of every book as recorded in the 27 books of the New Testament. Upon completion of this course, the student should be able to identify and comprehend the central theme of the New Testament, gain more than a passing familiarity with the context and purpose of each book and develop an inspired passion for studying the New Testament.</p>
<p>Authority of The Believer Monday 9/18 – 11/06/23 7:00 pm – 9 :00 pm Minister Tanzy Cullar</p>	<p>The objective of this course is to equip the students with the knowledge of their God given authority and to empower them to live the life of an Overcomer.</p>
<p>Miracles, Signs &amp; Wonders Thursday 9/21 – 11/09/23 7:00 pm – 9:00 pm Pastor Tehran Frazier</p>	<p>This course will describe and demonstrate the power and purpose of Miracles, Signs and Wonders. Students will learn what is needed for them to operate in Miracles, Signs and Wonders.</p>

<p>Spiritual Warfare  Monday 9/18 – 11/06/23  7:00 pm – 9:00 pm  Minister Kyle Odom</p>	<p>In this course you will learn the authority that God has given to us through the works of Jesus Christ. This course will bring to light the spiritual forces that causes us to triumph over the enemy in every battle. This course will likewise expose the enemies lies about our position in this spiritual warfare and the truth of God's love for justice while on the earth. Lastly, you will be empowered through the life of faith patriarchs in the scripture to be victory minded regardless of the battle.</p>
<p>Apologetics 101  Tues 9/19 – 11/07/23  7:00 pm – 9 pm  Minister Nikki Winston</p>	<p>In this course, we will uncover proof that truth does exist, God exists, miracles are possible, and that the New Testament is true. We will also explore the 6 most common arguments that atheists have against God, an how each of them actually shows there is a God, and He is the God of the Bible, As a bonus we will also briefly cover hermeneutics: proper interpretation of the Bible.</p>
<p>Book of Romans  Thurs 9/21– 11/09/23  7:00 pm – 9 pm  Pastor Ray Thomas</p>	<p>This course is an expositional study of the book of Romans. This is the very first letter that appears after the Book of Acts in the New Testament. The book of Romans is crucial to the understanding of salvation and sanctification. Upon taking this class, one will understand the implications of sin and the fall of man. One will gain a better awareness of the relationship between justification, sanctification, and glorification. One will recognize the place of the Law as written in the Old Testament and why salvation is solely based on the merits of Jesus Christ.</p>
