Classes	Descriptions
1st & 2nd Corinthians Minister John King Monday – 9/28 – 11/16/2026 7pm – 9pm (central standard time) Virtual class only	This course is designed to take an in-depth study of the Epistles of 1st & 2nd Corinthians. This includes applying the Gospel to every area of life to foster Unity, holiness, and love within the church and finding strength in weakness through the power of God.
The Book of Genesis Minister Jason Williams Monday – 9/28– 11/16/2026 7pm – 9pm (central standard time) Virtual class only	This course is designed to give students a clear understanding of the foundation of the kingdom of God through the book of Genesis. Students will discover God’s original intent for humanity, develop a deeper awareness of their identity and authority, and be equipped to take intentional next steps in living as kingdom citizens aligned with God’s purpose.
Kingdom Marriage Toolbox: Practical Principles for Singles, Married and Ministers. Minister Niki Winston Monday – 9/28-11-16/2026 7pm-9pm (central standard time) Virtual class only	How can we Practically apply God’s Word to have a Godly, Purposeful and Satisfying Christian Marriage? The answers to every marriage question are found in the Word of God: What does it mean to be the head of the home? What is the foundational key to being prepared to be a spouse? What do love and respect look like from a biblical standpoint? How does a spouse forgive when it’s hard to forget? Does the Bible have the key to turning around an unhappy marriage? Turn over

Study of the “ITES” Minister Tanzy Cullar Tuesday – 9/29 –11/17/26 7pm – 9pm (central standard time) Virtual class only	In this 8-week study, students will explore the “ITES” weren’t just ancient nations: they reveal the exact spiritual progression that still can effect believers today. Their collective name forms an unforgettable acronym: ITES – Influence – Tempt-Entangle – Sin. By the end of this course, students will have a deeper understanding of their position in Christ, their role within the body of believers, and how to stand in spiritual battle while walking in love, unity and power.
The Epistles of John I, II and III John Minister Amir Rauf Tuesday – 9/29 – 11/17/26 7pm – 9pm (central standard time) Virtual class only	This 8-week Bible study explores the Epistles of John through a commentary lens in simple and clear terms. Students will learn the main ideas about love, truth obedience, and living as followers of Christ. The course explains how John encouraged early Christians to stay faithful, guarding against error, and caring for one another emphasizing the importance of fellowship.
Spiritual Warfare Min. Kyle Odom Thursday – 10/01 - 11/19/26 7pm- 9pm (central standard time) Virtual class only	Students will gain a concrete awareness of the battle that has been waged against God’s people since the fall of Satan and the work of God through Jesus to give those who trust in him supernatural victory in every spiritual battle. This course will also feed your faith and strengthen your spiritual muscles that will allow you to walk into the manifestation of the finished works of Jesus Christ that was made manifest through His death, burial, resurrection and ascension.
Miracles, Signs & Wonders Pastor Tehran Frazier Thursday – 10/01 – 11/19/26 7pm – 9 pm (central standard time) Virtual class only	This course will describe and demonstrate the power and Purpose of Miracles, Signs and Wonders.
